At-Risk Behaviors

The following are 5 principle categories of behaviors that indicate risk for committing a first offense. The behaviors in each category have been found to be part of the profile of juvenile offenders. **Referral to the Prevention Program may be considered if one or more behaviors in at least two areas is checked.**

1. Antisocial/acting out behavior

- Difficulty managing anger*
- Aggressive or violent behaviors*
- Lack of respect for rules*
- Difficulty with honesty*
- Foul language*
- Fire-setting*
- Sexual acting out*
- Other behavior outside the norm*
- Threatens to run away*

2. School problems

- Poor attendance*
- Low grades*
- Incomplete assignments/Work not turned in*
- Difficulties with reading, math or writing*
- Lack of participation in school activities*
- School behavior issues/suspensions/expulsions*

3. Poor family functioning

- Lack of necessities*
- Family stressors, i.e. frequent moves, deaths*
- Witnessing violence and abuse*
- Victim of physical, emotional or sexual abuse*
- Poor family communication*
- Poor parental involvement or supervision*
- Parental attitudes support criminality/violence*

4. Substance abuse

- Experimentation or use of alcohol*
- Experimentation or use of illegal drugs*
- Experimentation or use of tobacco*
- Exposure in family setting to substance abuse*

5. Poor peer relationship

- Bullying*
- Victim of Bullying*
- Loner*
- Gang or Wannabe gang affiliation*
