Commissioner Huxley, on Friday 11/10/17 commissioner Boice called me, at my home (b) (1) (A), about my objection to loaning our public money (road fund) to a Medical center to finance an emergency center here in Brookings.

Mr. Huxley, I was in business for twenty five years. When I needed to borrow money I always went to my bank to get a loan. I never went to a public agency to get a loan for my company. Before the bank loaned me the money I had to put up my assets to cover the loan. Why doesn't this medical center do the same thing. I believe the road fund should be used on our county roads, which could use some work done on them now.

This borrowing of funds reminds me of the federal government borrowing our Social Security funds for other uses. And we don't know if that will ever be paid back.

Mr. Huxley, not too long ago the south district voted down the idea that we property owners could be taxed to help pay for the medical center (hospital in Gold Beach). I think the tax payers spoke clearly when we voted down the tax.

I would like for you to read this letter at the next public meeting.
