- 2. Approval of Agenda:** Becky Campbell made a motion to approve the agenda, Wendy Lang seconded, all in favor.
- 3. Approval of Minutes:** Sheriff Ward made a motion to approve the January and February minutes as presented, Joshua Spansail seconded, all in favor.
- 4. Public Comment:** None

5. **Old Business:**
  - a. Opioid Addiction Assistance: Erin Porter with Curry Community Health reported that they will resume medically assisted treatment for opiate addiction next month.
  
6. **New Business:**
  - a. Officer Elect 2020 Secretary: The election of a new secretary has been continued since February as Christine Neil's term was up. Sheriff Ward nominated Wendy Lang then followed with the motion; Joshua Spansail seconded the motion, all in favor.
  - b. David Denney advised that Adult Parole and Probation have a prisoner getting released from Oregon State Prison and they are on high alert of COVID 19. The parolee will be asked to quarantine in an apartment provided by P & P for two weeks before they enter into the community. They will also offer them testing on their arrival. There was some discussion on possible COVID assistance through DOC and grants.

Judge Beaman made a motion to offer remote meetings and Christopher Paasch seconded, all in favor.
