Effective Friday, January 15th 2021 – January 28th, 2021

Curry County will be moving from Extreme Risk to Moderate Risk under the state's framework for assessing the risk posed by the spread of COVID-19. This level will be effective from **Friday, January 15th, 2021 to January 28th, 2021**.

What does this mean? It means that the governor will allow us to ease restrictions on some business and personal activities. See below related OHA guide to risk levels and restrictions.
